# Job Description Kingswood University

Position Title: Director of Student Life

Classification: 30 hours/week

**Responsible To:** Executive Vice President

**Purpose:** To support the mission of Kingswood University by leading, coordinating, and

enhancing all aspects of student life.

**Goal**: To provide strategic leadership to create a supportive and engaging environment

that promotes the spiritual, emotional, and social development of students.

### Responsibilities:

### 1. Student Life Leadership & Vision

- Provide leadership, vision, and strategic direction for student engagement initiatives, ensuring alignment with the university's mission, vision, and values.
- Oversee the development and implementation of student-centered programs for oncampus and online students, including spiritual formation, social activities, leadership development, and student organizations.
- Work closely with university administration, faculty, and staff to promote a Christian ethos across campus life.

#### 2. Student Development & Engagement

- Develop and execute programs that foster spiritual growth, personal development, and community involvement.
- Provide guidance and mentorship to student leaders and organizations, helping them create meaningful and purposeful activities.
- Collaborate with enrolment, residence life, and academic departments to create opportunities for student engagement both inside and outside the classroom.
- Organize and support regular campus events such as retreats, worship nights, service projects, and cultural events.

#### 3. Resident Life Oversight

- Oversee campus housing and residence life programs, ensuring a safe, supportive, and spiritually enriching living environment.
- Collaborate with the Residence Life team to provide programming that encourages community-building, conflict resolution, and personal growth within residence halls.

### 4. Student Wellness & Support Services

- Ensure that student wellness programs (mental, emotional, and physical health) are aligned with the Christian mission of the university.
- Serve as a point of contact for students in need of counseling, pastoral care, or crisis support, offering referrals as necessary.

• Collaborate with campus counselors, chaplains, and student support services to promote the well-being of students.

### 5. Collaboration and Communication

- Build and maintain relationships with students, faculty, staff, and external community partners to enhance student life.
- Serve as a liaison between students and administration to ensure effective communication and advocacy for student needs.
- Regularly assess and evaluate student satisfaction and the effectiveness of student life programs, making recommendations for improvement.

#### 6. Administrative Duties

- Develop and manage the Student Life department budget, ensuring fiscal responsibility and alignment with institutional goals.
- Supervise and mentor Student Life staff, providing professional development and support.
- Assist in student orientation, new student programming, and other major campus events.
- Maintain accurate records and reports related to Student Life activities, student involvement, and program outcomes.
- View this position as a ministry, including mentoring students in their Christian walk as opportunities arise in the fulfillment of your responsibilities.
- Participate in University events, including regular chapel attendance, as available.
- Perform additional duties, as required.

- Bachelor's degree in ministry or a related field required; master's degree preferred.
- Experience in student affairs, campus life, student ministry, with at least 2 years in a supervisory capacity.
- Experience in developing and leading student engagement programs.
- Collaborative mindset, including ability to lead, manage, or participate in cross-functional teams.
- Experience in crisis management, conflict resolution, and providing pastoral care and support to students.
- Good interpersonal communication skills including listening, relating, diplomacy, tact, and creative problem solving.
- Willing to work flexible hours to accommodate the campus life schedule and urgent student needs.
- Understanding of and ability to communicate Christian values and beliefs to students.
